# Facility Naming Program

### **Recognition for Major Donations**



New and existing facilities may be named in recognition of donors to the College, Education Foundation, or Scholarship Foundation.

The name recognition may be provided to an individual, organization, or company that makes a significant monetary or in-kind contribution. The types of recognition and level of financial contribution are:

- \$10,000 to \$100,000: Naming of a specific location, such as classrooms, labs, meeting rooms and offices.
- \$100,000 to \$1,000,000: Naming of campus areas or spaces within buildings such as patios, lobbies, sports fields, the bookstore, or cafeteria.
- \$1,000,000+: Existing buildings may be named, such as the library or gymnasium on the main campus or other buildings at any SCC location.
- For naming of an entire new building, the contribution required may be the actual cost of construction.

Each naming recognition must be consistent with mission and goals of Solano Community College. The District Governing Board must approve the facility name upon a recommendation of the College Superintendent-President in consultation with the SCC Educational Foundation and/or SCC Scholarship Foundation as appropriate.

The Solano Community College Automotive Technology program needs your help! SCC developed a state-of-the-art Alternative and Renewable Fuel and Vehicle Technology Program with funding from the California Energy Commission. The College then re-established the Automotive Technician program in Spring 2013. Students have the option to earn an Automotive Technician Associate of Science Degree; or Certificates in Automatic Transmissions and Transaxles, Automotive Electrical and Body Systems, and/or Automotive Maintenance and Light Repair. In the fall of 2017, a new 30,000 sq. ft. facility was dedicated. Below is a list of the spaces available for naming.
